Hello, beloved Saints of God! I hope this edition of *The Messenger* finds you well and in good care.

I've been reading a book that was given to me back in 1977. Talk about some procrastination! It was one of those books that I told myself I would read later. Well, for me, the time has come. It's called <u>Fully Human, Fully Alive: A New Life through a</u> <u>New Vision</u> by John Powell, S.J.

Powell lists six insights that "profoundly changed" his life. He states that these insights deeply affected his lifestyle and the perceptions of things he sees and how he responds to the world.

Let me share with you the first of the six:

• Obnoxious qualities (lying, bragging, gossiping, temper tantrums, etc.) in myself and in others are really cries of pain and appeals for help.

This certainly spoke to me and I was only on page 3! LOL. Who knows how long it will take before I get through it?!

How can I begin to think that any of these things are okay? Unless I look at these behaviors from the perspective of someone (including me) in need of help with some deep pain, I am simply making judgement.

How can I begin to judge those moments in others or myself without thinking there must be some sense "of pain or appeal for help"? How do I begin to help myself or others I encounter? I need to begin to look into the depths of humanness and see that something deeper is going on.

There is a sense of lack in a person's life that is desperately seeking some wholeness – some cry to be fully alive. I know that when I am living out such behaviors I may be going through something that is bigger than the moment. I must take some time to reflect, meditate, and seek help from a God who has always desired me to be fully human and yet to be fully alive.

Here is the challenge. When I react in a certain way that brings harm, then I am not living in a fully human and fully alive way. My perceptions tell me that I am lacking insight to a situation that is in need. I must seek the deep parts of my being, to seek out God and others who can help me find the true meaning of who I am. I'm up for it; how about you?

I pray that this speaks to you today. Let us seek God; he will be waiting for us to restore all there is to restore according to His will.

God bless and don't forget to be kind to yourself and to others.
